

# FIRE (ISMA'IL) AND BLOOD (ISHAO)

## THE SEVEN SIGNS OF ISA

Isa followed Ibrahim's example and gave up life to death, as the Greater Son of Ibrahim, Friend of Allah. He said in Matthew 8:20: 'Foxes have dens and birds of the air have nests but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head.' Isa said to Pitras his closest disciple when Pitras wanted to fight: 'Pitras! Put away your sword...My Kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight...' Like Ibrahim, Isa waited for Allah's promise, in Allah's time and by Allah's sovereign Will and Power. Because Isa humbled Himself and gave Himself up to death in a supreme act Taslim, even on a Cross of shame, Allah highly exalted Him as King. Isa demonstrated His Kingship of the Kingdom to come by performing seven signs.

# THE FIRST SIGN – ISA TURNED WATER INTO WINE YUHAN 2:1-11

At a wedding feast in Qana in Al-Jumhuriyah al Lubnaniyah. He, his mother and his disciples were invited. When the wine ran out, Isa turned water into wine. The guests said it was the best wine of the whole wedding feast.

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# THE SECOND SIGN – HEALING OF A CHILD YUHAN 4:46-54

Once more Isa visited Qana in el-Jelil, where he had turned the water into wine. And there was a certain royal official whose son lay sick at Kafr Naum. When this man heard that Isa had arrived in el-Jelil from Yahudiya, he went to him and begged him to come and heal his son, who was close to death. "Unless you people see signs and wonders," Isa told him, "you will never believe." The royal official said, "Sir, come down before my child dies." "Go," Isa replied, "your son will live." The man took Isa at his word and departed. While he was still on the way, his servants met him with the news that his boy was living. When he inquired as to the time when his son got better, they said to him, "Yesterday, at one in the afternoon, the fever left him." Then the father realized that this was the exact time at which Isa had said to him. "Your son will live." So he and his whole household believed.

# THE THIRD SIGN – HEALING AT THE POOL YUHAN 5:1-11

Some time later, Isa went up to Urshalim for one of the Jewish festivals. Now there is near the Sheep Gate a pool, which in Aramaic is called Bethesda and which is surrounded by five covered colonnades. Here a great number of disabled people used to lie—the blind, the lame, the paralysed. One who was there had been an invalid for thirty-eight years. When Isa saw him lying there and learned that he had been in this condition for a long time, he asked him, "Do you want to get well?" "Sir," the invalid replied, "I have no one to help me into the pool when the water is stirred. While I am trying to get in, someone else goes down ahead of me." Then Isa said to him, "Get up! Pick up your mat and walk." At once the man was cured; he picked up his mat and walked. The day on which this took place was a Sabbat, and so the Jewish leaders said to the man who had been healed, "It is the Sabbat; the law forbids you to carry your mat." But he replied, "The man who made me well said to me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'

# THE FOURTH SIGN – FEEDING THE 5000 YUHAN 6:5-145

When Isa looked up and saw a great crowd coming toward him, he said to Fileeb, "Where shall we buy bread for these people to eat?" He asked this only to test him, for he already had in mind what he was going to do. Fileeb answered him, "It would take more than half a year's wages to buy enough bread for each one to have a bite!" Another of his disciples, Indrivas, Sim'an Pitras' brother, spoke up, "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish, but how far will they go among so many?" Isa said, "Have the people sit down." There was plenty of grass in that place, and they sat down (about five thousand men were there). Isa then took the loaves, gave thanks and distributed to those who were seated as much as they wanted. He did the same with the fish. When they had all had enough to eat, he said to his disciples, "Gather the pieces that are left over. Let nothing be wasted." So they gathered them and filled twelve baskets with the pieces of the five barley loaves left over.

# THE FIFTH SIGN – ISA WALKS ON THE WATER YUHAN 6:16-24

When evening came, his disciples went down to the lake, where they got into a boat and set off across the lake for Kafr Nahum. By now it was dark, and Isa had not yet joined them. A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Isa approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were frightened. But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.

### THE SIXTH SIGN – ISA HEALS THE MAN BORN BLIND YUHAN 9:1-7

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As he went along, Isa saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked Him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind? "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Isa, "but this happened so that the works of Allah might be displayed in him. As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world." After saying this, he spit on the ground, made some mud with the saliva, and put it on the man's eyes "Go," he told him, "wash in the Pool of Siloam" (this word means "Sent"). So the man went and washed, and came home seeing.

# THE SEVENTH SIGN – ISA RAISES LAZARUS FROM DEATH YUHAN 11:1-45

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Maryam and her sister Martha told Isa their brother Lazarus was sick. Isa said, "This sickness will not end in death. No, it is for Allah's glory". Now Isa loved Martha and her sister and Lazarus. But when he heard that Lazarus was sick, he stayed where he was two more days. Then he said to his disciples, "Let us go back to Yahudiya. Our friend Lazarus has fallen asleep; but I am going there to wake him up." Isa's disciples thought he meant natural sleep. Is a then told them plainly, "Lazarus is dead and for your sake I am glad I was not there, so that you may believe. But let us go to him." Isa, once more deeply moved, came to the tomb, a cave with a stone laid across the entrance. "Take away the stone," he said. "Lord," said Martha, "by this time he will smell. He has been there four days." Isa said, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of Allah?" So they took away the stone. Then Isa looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. Then he called in a loud voice, "Lazarus, come out!" Lazarus came out, his hands and feet wrapped with strips of linen, and a cloth around his face. Isa said, "Take off the grave clothes. Let him go." Many Jews who had come to visit Mary believed in Isa.

# ISA'S RESURRECTION FROM THE DEAD - THE GREATEST SIGN YUHAN 20

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Early on Sunday morning while it was still dark, Maryam Magdani came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance. She ran and told Sim'an Pitras and also Yahya: "They have taken the Lord's body out of the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!" Pitras and Yahya ran to the tomb. Yahya outran Pitras, reached the tomb first and stooped to look in. He saw the linen wrappings lying there but didn't go in. When Sim'an Pitras arrived he went in and also noticed the linen wrappings lying there, while the cloth covering Isa' head was folded up, lying separately.. They still had not understood the Scriptures that said Isa must rise from the dead. They went home. Maryam stood outside the tomb crying. She stooped to look in and saw two white-robed angels. "Dear woman, why are you crying?" they asked. "They have taken away my Lord," she replied. As she left, she saw a gardener standing there. She did not recognize it was Isa. "Sir," she said, "have you taken him away?" "Maryam!" Isa said: She cried out, "Rabboni!" She found the disciples saying: "I have seen the Lord!". Isa later appeared to the disciples and then over 40 days to many more people, both individuals and groups.

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
